### **Summary of the Coastal Community Challenge meeting on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2016**

Some of the committee met to put together the Annual Review for Big Local showing what work had been carried out against the budget and how it had benefitted the residents of our area.

Our area has been chosen from the first 50 areas to be part of an evaluation to determine the impact the £1m has had on the area. A representative from R4C, who are carrying out the evaluation, is to come and talk to some of those who have received money from the CCC.

The employment of a Development Worker was being looked into to determine whether or not it was needed.

Experience Enterprise Lincolnshire Limited have been commissioned to help the unemployed in the area to become self employed.

It had been agreed to provide a new Website and that it be updated regularly in order to keep residents informed of the CCC's progress.

Defibrillators had been ordered and would be placed at the Coastal Centre, Community Hall, Coastwatch Station, Sutton on Sea Post Office and Trusthorpe Village Hall.

It was agreed to look into further finance for East Lindsey Advice Project who provide an advice service on various matters. This takes place at the Coastal Centre on Tuesday mornings and it was thought that another day would be useful at Sutton on Sea. A revised budget figure was awaited for consideration.

It was reported that the Children's Christmas parties in December 2015 at the Mablethorpe Community Hall and Meridale at Sutton on Sea were a success and the children enjoyed the hot food, entertainment, prizes, balloons and not forgetting the present from Santa.

### **Grant meeting 27<sup>th</sup> January 2016**

This was a grant meeting to consider applications received before the closing date of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2015.

Applications received were from:

Mablethorpe Town Council – contribution towards the cost of replacing the moveable walls that had come to the end of their useful life. £5,000

Sutton on Sea Gardening Club – gardening equipment: lawnmower, traffic cones, strimmer, loppers, spades, forks, high viz vests etc. £1,189

Mablethorpe & District Motor Club - Host a an event in May 2016 to promote the club and provide free entertainment for all ages. £1,450

Beach Bar Boxing Club - to purchase a new ring to ABA specification and adapt the building to include toilet facilities. £5,000

Mablethorpe Community Hall – Contribution towards the cost of replacing the front entrance doors with automatic doors. £5,000

Sutton on Sea Barn Dancing Club – IT equipment £1,100

### October

Maltby Players - purchase of costumes, scenery, sound equipment and venue hire. £3,226

Sutton on Sea Library Hub - IT equipment to deliver additional services. £ 350
