Frequency Music Project

soundLINCS are delivering a Music Technology project in Sutton-on-Sea Primary school. Sixty year 4 pupils are half way through a 20 week project to develop their own electronic music to accompany computer games. Using the school IT suite, Eddy, the soundLINCS Music Facilitator, is using a web-based music production package called soundation with the group. Soundation allows pupils, to produce, edit and create their own songs in an online studio, using short musical loops. Since the project began, 15 young people have chosen to continue work on their tracks outside of school time. Integral to Frequency is the opportunity for staff to learn about the functionality of soundation. CPD sessions will be tailored to staff needs.
