Exercise on Referral

Marisco Patient Group were awarded a grant to fund 50:50 referrals from Marisco to Station Sports Centre. If you are a member of the Marisco Patient Group just ask your clinician if you can be referred under the scheme and the practice will complete the forms for you. If you have had a health review or seen a clinician and had a Blood Test, Blood Pressure checked, or been advised to lose weight in the last three months you may not need to see anyone, just contact the patient group and you may be eligible straight away. As a bonus, patients on the scheme will also be able to use both Meridian and Embassy swimming pools at no extra charge.
