**Our grant funded activities are based around five themes that have been agreed as part of our plan.**

**Community Cohesion:** projects that focus on bringing residents together to socialise, learn and develop new skills, and develop facilities that improve wellbeing and strengthen the community.

**Young People:** activities, outings and opportunities for young people.

**Community Facilities:** support for community meeting places and help with issues such as debt, welfare advice, and nutrition and diet.

**Older People:** aiming to reduce loneliness and isolation and to assist people living with conditions such as dementia.

**Arts & Heritage:** raising awareness and engaging the community in local heritage and access to the arts.



The community turned out in force on 9 December for the **C.C.C Christmas Extravaganza**. Our Chairman, John Gregory, said: "It was wonderful to see

so many people brave the cold to attend. Our thanks go to everyone who supported the event and helped to make it such a success."

## LOOKING BACK ON 2017

These are the grants awarded by C.C.C. last year



### A spot of horticulture!

Mablethorpe and Sutton RAFA group (pictured below) was awarded **£500** towards a concert to celebrate the centenary of the RAF.

The Horticultural Society used a **£3,500** grant to buy a new marquee, tables and chairs. In July, visitors flocked to view the society's exhibition (pictured above) which included flowers, floral art, cookery, handicrafts, vegetables and children's displays.



Viva Sinfonia received **£5,000** towards a cultural music event (pictured below).



We were pleased to support the 3rd Annual Beach Hut Festival by sponsoring the first aid for the event.



BriJen Line Dancing group was awarded **£200** towards a new lightweight speaker.

Mablethorpe & District Motor Club received a grant of **£500** for a free Family Fun Day and Classic Car Display.

St Peter's PCC was awarded **£500** for specialist renovation work.

Sutton on Sea Residents Association was awarded **£500** towards The Furlongs Festival.

Mabo Miniatures were awarded **£100** for a community event.

Friends of Mablethorpe Base received **£202.07** for resources and equipment.

The Enterprise Hall, Sutton on Sea received **£5,000** for new entrance doors.

Mablethorpe Community Hall received a **£4,260** grant to install LED lighting.

Furnichurch was awarded a grant to purchase foodbank provisions.

St Mary's PCC, Mablethorpe received a grant of **£2,775** for building improvements at St Mary's Church Hall.

Mablethorpe Athletic Club was awarded **£1,700** for the cost of upgrading kitchen facilities.

CCC were pleased to award a grant for the Fire Show at St Peter's Annexe in Trusthorpe (pictured below), as part of the Carnival Week launch event for Sutton on Sea and Trusthorpe Carnival.
