### 5. Lincolnshire Community Foundation

LED light bulb replacements – SF has not heard back from The Coastal Centre, St Peters Methodist, St Clements, SOS Football Club, EF Church, Mablethorpe ATC or Mablethorpe Brownies & Guides. The Town Council have paid for the LED lighting in Meridale. SF to clarify with Furnichurch that it is replacement LED bulbs not fixtures. A £200 Community Chest grant was unanimously agreed for Enterprise Craft Group to purchase craft resources. A £200 Community Chest grant was unanimously agreed for Craft & Chatter Group for craft resources. A £200 Community Chest grant was agreed for MUGS towards an amplifier. £300 was awarded to St Clements Short Mat Bowls Club towards a Hoover, cooler/heater fans, jacks & chalks.

It was proposed, seconded and agreed that to limit Community Chest grants awarded to any one group, to 3 applications within the lottery lifetime.

SF read out a letter of thanks from Maddie Gledhill (MASA) who was a recipient of funding for replacement LED bulbs. The survey on Trusthorpe Village Hall had been circulated to members. SF to write to the Chairman to ask if they would like to re-submit their original grant application or a revised one.
