Our usual grant schemes have continued throughout the pandemic and, despite many groups having to reduce their activities, we have invested in our community by funding the **replacement of the extension roof at Mablethorpe OAP Hall**, refurbishing the toilets at Mablethorpe Community Hall, **providing laptops for students at many of our local schools** and purchasing a new set of livery for our Town Crier.

LN12 is a new, not for profit, social enterprise designed to improve the lives of and reduce social and economic inequalities for people living in Mablethorpe, Trusthorpe & Sutton on Sea by providing services, opportunities and employment for local people. Ultimately, the aim is for it to be led by and for local residents, addressing the most urgent needs identified by the people and communities we intend to support. The long term vision is to create caring, inclusive and prosperous places in which to live.



The types of services and opportunities that the company provides will vary depending on the need, but these are likely to be those not met by other organisations and may include:

- Support staying warm in the Winter
- Help getting and staying online
- Access to and the delivery of training and education opportunities
- Access to more jobs and good quality work
- Access to tradespeople
- Energy Efficiency (switching providers)
- Better healthcare services

We would also like to take this opportunity to thank ELAP for their work in supporting and advising residents, over the last 6 years, and wish them every success with their future endeavours.



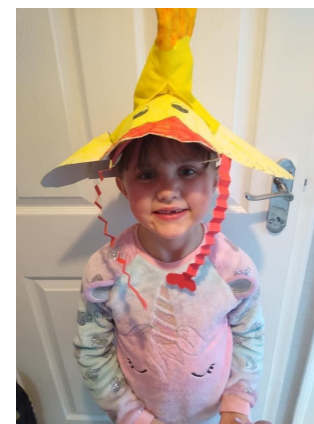
